Please listen when a leader is talking

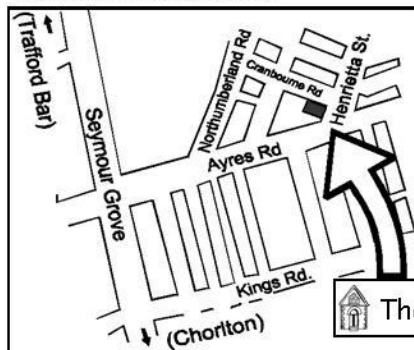
Please do not go outside without a leader

Tuesday club activities are run on a voluntary basis by members of the church.

Who? Children aged 7 to 11

When? Tuesdays 6.30pm to 8.00pm

Where? The 'Bethel' Christadelphian Church,
Henrietta St, Old Trafford.

We also take the children to local parks during the summer, visit Urmston swimming baths every couple of months and leave the premises for other activities, for example visits to fire stations. You will see on the programme when these occasions are.

We ask that all children pay 20p a week to come to club, this helps towards the cost of the materials we use during the activities. We also have a tuck shop at which the children can spend up to 30p a week.

We follow the Children's Act good practice guidelines in protecting the children and creating a safe secure environment. In order to comply with government guidance and keep our records up to date, we ask for signed parental permission for children to attend club each week. When we reach our maximum we have a waiting list for new children. If your child is absent for 6 weeks we will assume they no longer want to come and their place will be given to the next person on the list.
